CRITERIA FOR CENTENNIAL FARM RECOGNITION: (Who can apply)

- 1. 100 years of continuous family ownership of agricultural land, with
 - a) a minimum size of 50 acres; and
 - b) direct descendants - male or female, or by marriage
- 2. Proof of ownership and dates provided and verified will allow for one of two kinds of presentation **(Check the one you feel you are eligible for)**
 - a) a plaque to the current owner
 - b) a certificate to celebrate 100 years of ownership, but land since sold

Note: The Manitoba Historical Society issues one plaque or one certificate - others will be at the family's expense. Plaques or certificates are not reissued when there is a generational change of ownership.
