Margaret McWilliams Awards 2021

The Margaret McWilliams Award, created in 1955 to honor the noted Manitoba author, recognizes excellence in materials relating to Manitoba's history. For 2021, awards will be made in the following categories:

- Scholarly Book
- Popular Book
- Local History Book

Eligibility criteria:

1. Submitted materials will pertain to Manitoba history.
2. Submissions must be published in English or French, either originally or in translation, during the 2021 calendar year.
3. Submissions must be more than 50 pages in length.
4. Self-published materials shall be eligible for submission but at least 100 copies must have been published and commercially distributed to the public through well-established channels such as retail stores or an online book-selling website.
5. The decision of the Manitoba Historical Society as to whether a submission is eligible shall be binding.
6. Multiple awards in any category may be given in the event of a tie.
7. Awards will not necessarily be made in every category.
8. Five (5) copies of each submission must be forwarded with the application form. All submissions become the property of the Manitoba Historical Society and will not be returned.

Effective 1 January 2021, a fee has been waived for all submissions.
