Margaret McWilliams Awards 2023

The Margaret McWilliams Award, created in 1955 to honor the noted Manitoba author, recognizes excellence in materials relating to Manitoba's history. For 2023, awards will be made in the

following categories:

- Scholarly Book
- Popular Book
- Local History Book

Eligibility criteria:

- The deadline for submissions is Wednesday, 1 March 2023.
- Submitted materials must pertain to Manitoba history and be published in the 2022 calendar year. Fictional works will only be considered if they deal with persons, events, or places in Manitoba history.
- Four copies of each submission must be forwarded with the application form. All submissions become the property of the MHS and will not be returned.
- Submissions must be published in English or French, either originally or in translation.
- Submissions must be more than 50 pages in length.
- Self-published materials shall be eligible for submission but at least 100 copies must have been published and commercially distributed to the public through well-established channels such as retail stores or an online book-selling website.
- The decision of the MHS as to the eligibility of a submission shall be binding.

Please note that the MHS reserves the right to switch submissions into a different category. Awards will not necessarily be made in every category and multiple awards may be given in the event of a tie.
