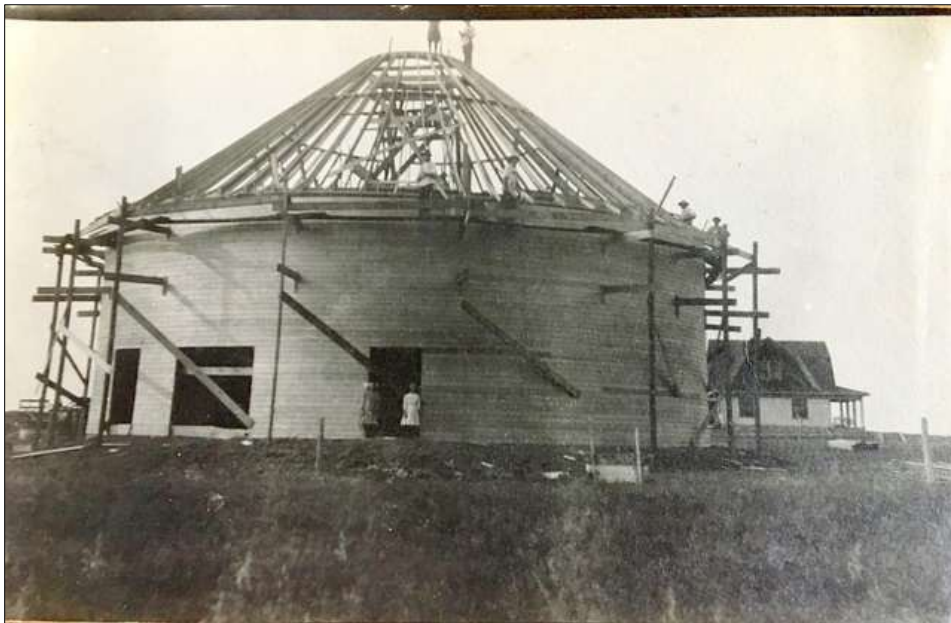

Rouleau area – Pamenter / Larson round barn, 1910

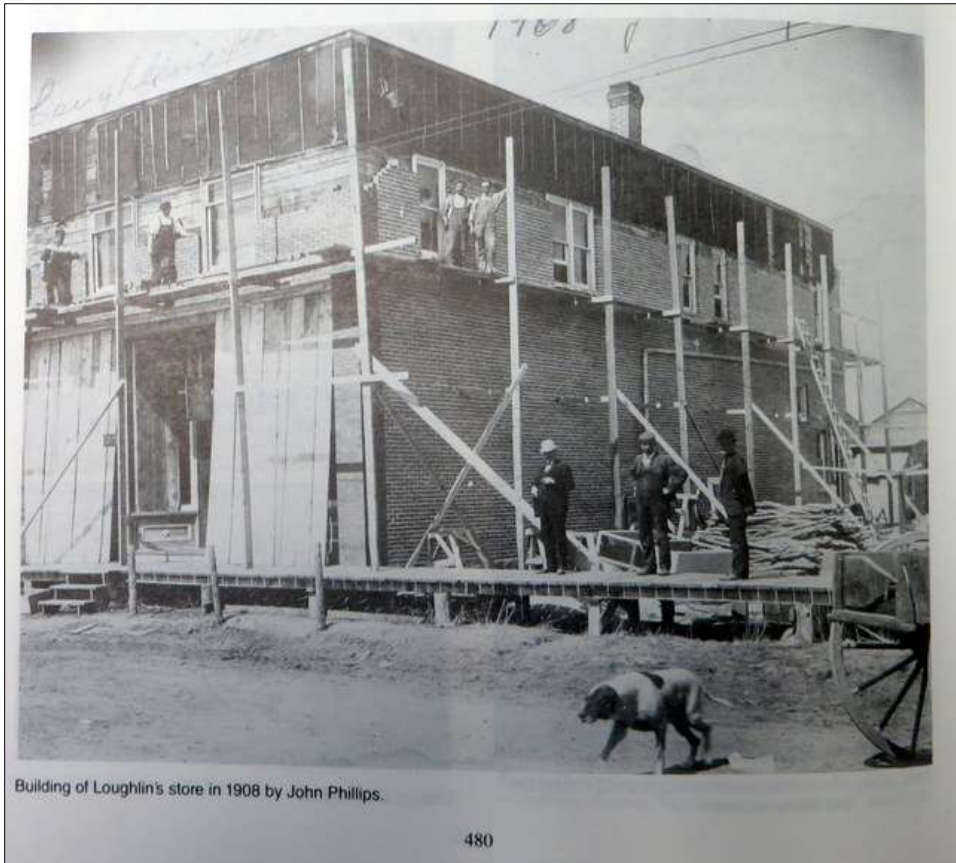

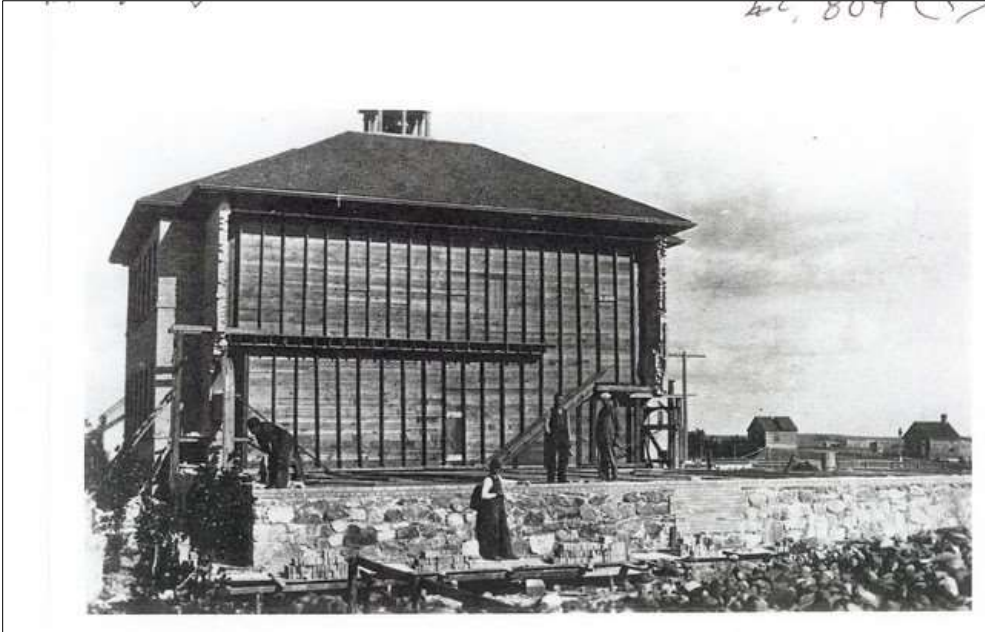

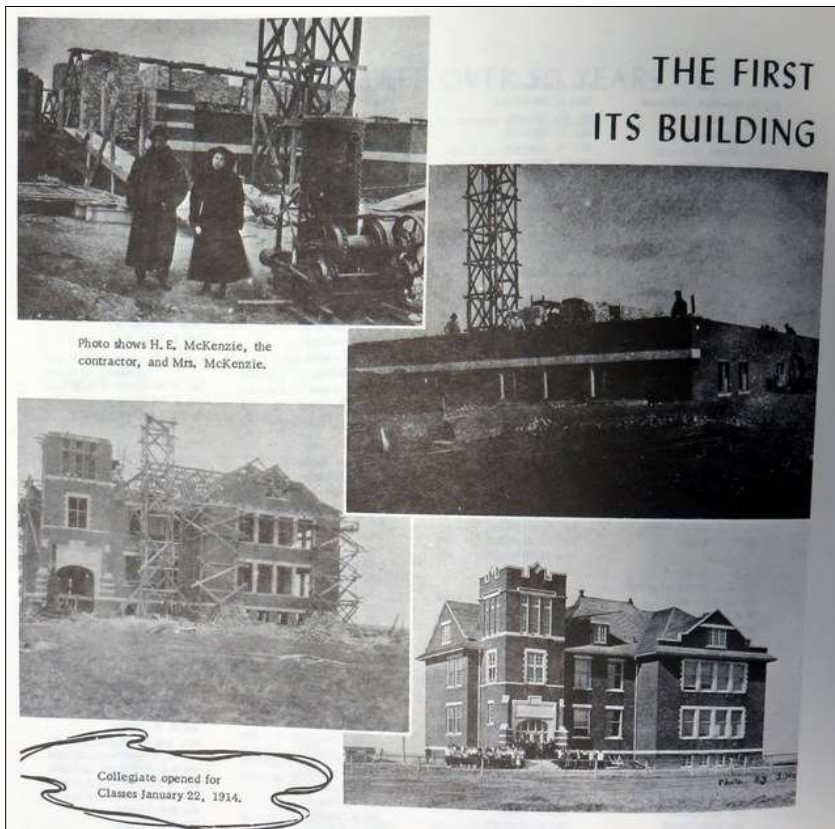

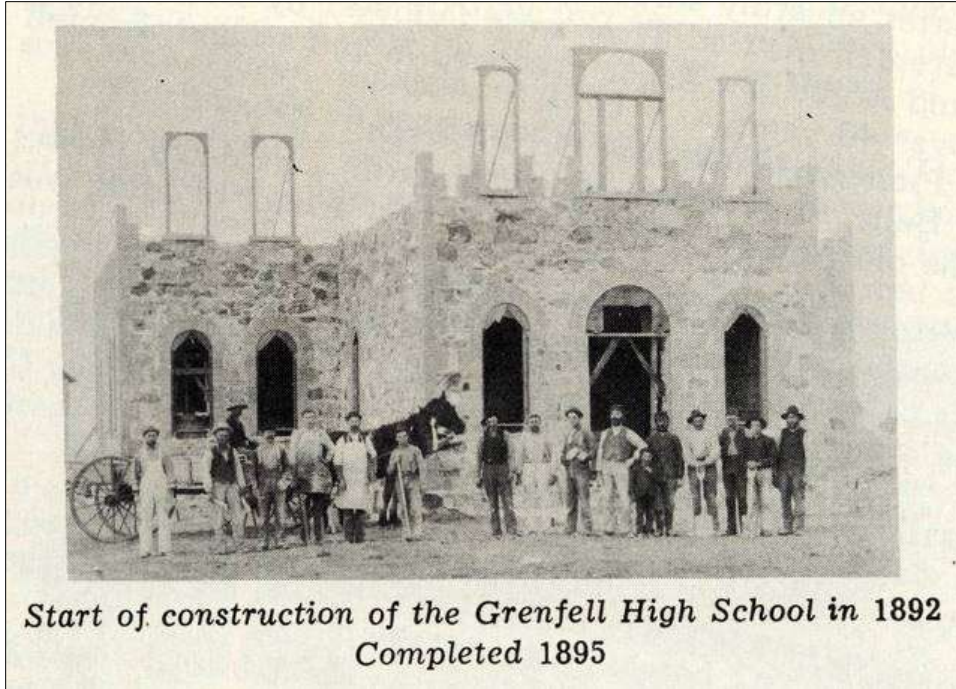


John Phillips building Central School.

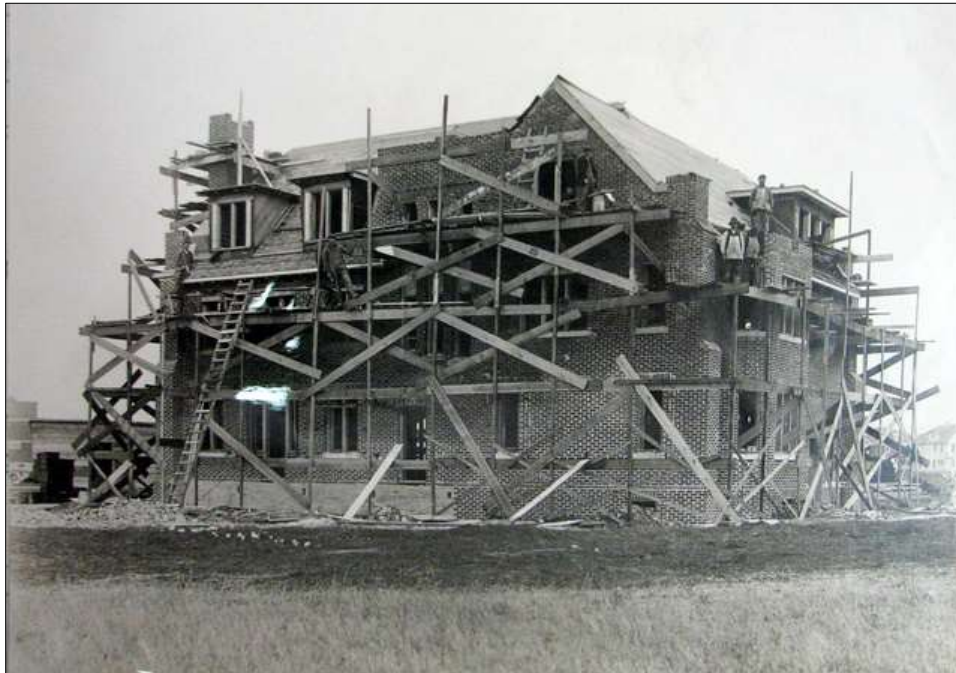


Estevan - Collegiate



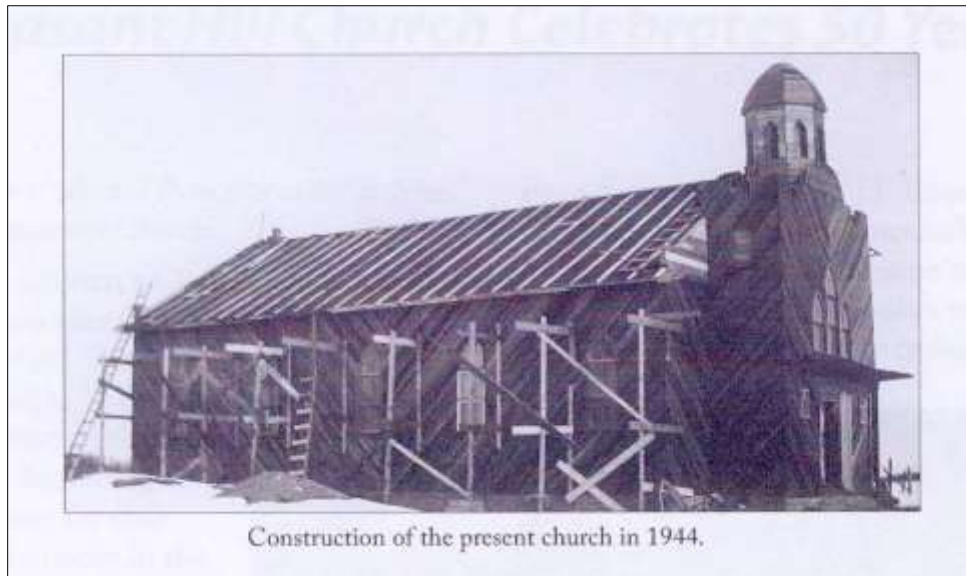

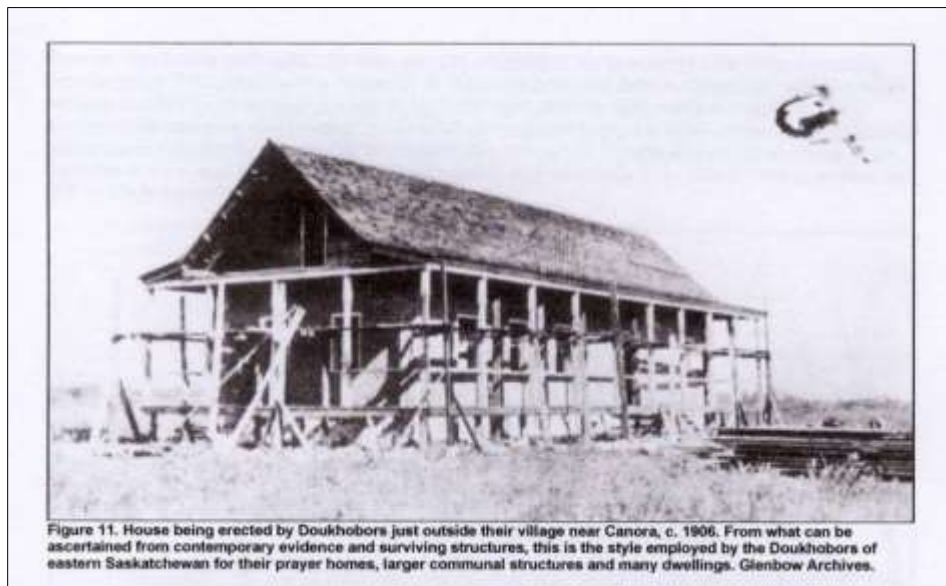

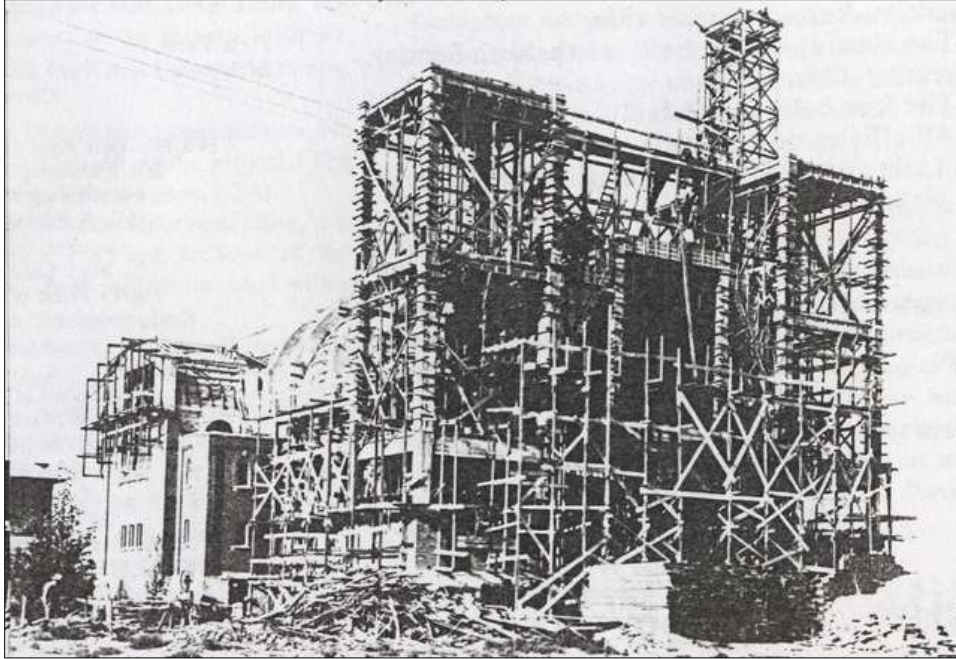
