Heaslip : 32-5-19 : 1883 -1892. S. A. Heaslip as postmaster and regional mail driver.

Sheppard's Ferry : 21-6-19 : 1883 – 1885 : John Sheppard
Sheppardville : 2-5-20 : 1883 - 191 : Robert Sheppard
Dempsey : 6-8-22 : 1891 – 1908 : James Dempsey

Fairfax : 24-6-2 : 1888 : Gwen Bercen listed as first Postmistress but Joseph Taylor from 1888-1899 at 32-5-20: Moved to village in 1899

Waneche / Wenetche : 36-5-22 : 1885 – 1892 L: David Gibson farm
Westhall : 4-5-22 : 1884 – 1918 : Mrs. E. Weightman
Underhill : 33-5-22 : 1900 - 1966 : Joseph W. Johnson : William Henry B. Hill
